

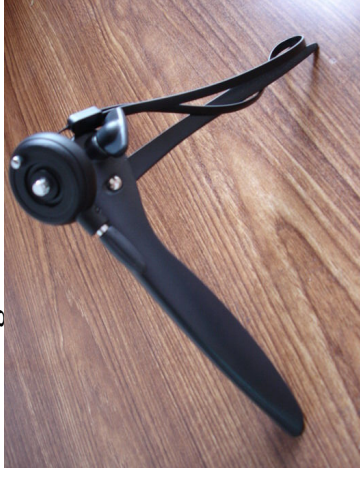

Features

Mounting



The spotting scope is supplied with a lightweight tabletop tripod, which is easily mounted on the scope. To attach the tripod to the scope firstly remove the tripod head from the legs by releasing the knurled handle. Now attach the tripod head to the scope by inserting the screw into the fitting in the bottom of the scope. Be sure to insert the location pin into the hole provided on the scope. Hand tighten with a small coin or screwdriver. Now you are ready to attach the tripod using the knurled handle to secure the scope to the tripod. The angle of the scope can be easily set using the knob on the side of the scope.

Focusing

The Nikko Stirling Platinum Nighteater Spotting Scope features a speed focusing adjustment dial located on the side of the scope. This provides ergonomic adjustment of the focus feature. It is advisable to begin focussing the scope with the Zoom set at the minimum level of 12X



Zoom 12X to 26X

The spotting scope allows the user to set the required level of zoom to 12X (times magnification) to 26X. This feature makes the scope more versatile.

The Zoom is set at the eyepiece. To adjust simply turn the rubber eye

piece to the setting required as marked on the eyepiece. (Caution: do not turn the whole eyepiece as it will become detached from the scope)

Carry Case

The carry case provided will provide protection in the field. We recommend the scope is always transported in a carry case. Our case features a handy pocket for the carrying of the tripod.



Care and maintenance.

The Spotting scope is designed to be waterproof. Lens care is vital, as only commercial optical cleaning products should be used. When cleaning moisten the cloth with the cleaning solution and start in the middle using a circular motion. The lenses are coated with ETC optical coatings. Poor lens cleaning will lead to lens scratching and deterioration. We recommend you consult your optics dealer for lens care products.

Warranty

When used under normal sporting conditions, The Nikko Stirling Platinum Nightteater Spotting Scope comes with a 12-month warranty, unless varied by local laws. Should you require service please contact the retailer who you bought the scope from to arrange return to our distributor in your country.
